

Our solution

Can an app really help with such a difficult problem? Yes!

We lower conflicts by breaking old communication patterns and create new ones. We also bring structure and **organization**. And a fair **economy**.

For example: if someone forgets to pack the winter gloves it's a source of conflict. If a parent sends a reminder text it's easy to misinterpret as criticism (another source of conflict).
